Subject: Transportation

Summary: This bill is a budget trailer bill related to transportation and is necessary to implement the Budget Act of 2026.

Proposed Law: This bill:

- 1) Deletes an erroneous zero that was added to the Zero-Emission Vehicle Incentive Trailer Bill in June.
- 2) Expands the existing California Highway Patrol security offerings for current and former legislators, judges, and constitutional officers to include their immediate family members and requires a threat reassessment at specific intervals.
- 3) Prohibits reducing vehicle lanes on a road serving two cemeteries in a city exceeding two million people unless specified public hearing, voting, and finding and declaration requirements are met. This definition applies to Forest Lawn Drive in the City of Los Angeles.
- 4) Increases a previous appropriation for the working drawings phase of the Leviathan Peak CHPERS tower replacement capital outlay project by \$198,000 from the General Fund.
