**The following information is revised to reflect amendments  
adopted by the committee on August 13, 2026**

**Fiscal Impact:** Costs to DOJ to establish and operate this program overall are unquantifiable and will require the hiring of personnel and securing technological expertise outside DOJ's existing scope and capabilities (General Fund).

**Author Amendments:** Require the Attorney General to check on a quarterly basis, whether ASTM International has published standards as specified, and if so, to publish written guidance if ASTM International has published industry standards for firearm blocking technology, as specified.

**Committee Amendments:** Delete enforcement provisions and narrow scope of the bill.

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
