The following information is revised to reflect amendments
adopted by the committee on August 13, 2026

Fiscal Impact:

- Unknown one-time and ongoing General Fund costs, likely high hundreds of thousands, for the California Health and Human Services Agency (CalHHS) for reporting requirements, advisory group facilitation, and serving as lead for the statewide governance group.
- Unknown ongoing costs, likely low hundreds of thousands, for the Emergency Medical Services Authority (EMSA) for state administration (988 State Suicide and Behavioral Health Crisis Services Fund).
- Unknown ongoing costs, likely low millions, for the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) to establish and maintain the statewide interoperability platform (988 State Suicide and Behavioral Health Crisis Services Fund).
- Unknown ongoing costs, potentially hundreds of thousands, for the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) for state administration (988 State Suicide and Behavioral Health Crisis Services Fund).
