



other than within the UC system, AANHPI students comprise a minority of California's public higher education system students. Supporters of this bill, such as the California Commission on Asian and Pacific Islander American Affairs, claim this bill's designation process "will encourage institutional accountability, strategic planning, and targeted support structures aligned with statewide equity and student success goals" and create "conditions where AANHPI students may flourish both academically and personally."

- 3) **Related Legislation.** SB 1255 (Reyes), of the current legislative session, creates the Designation of California Hispanic-Serving Institutions and names the CSU Chancellor's Office as managing entity. SB 1255 was referred to the Senate Committee on Appropriations suspense file.
- 4) **Prior Legislation.** SB 1348 (Bradford), Chapter 627, Statutes of 2024, established the Designation for Black-Serving Institutions, managed by the CSU Statewide Central Office for the Advancement of Black Excellence.
