The following information is revised to reflect amendments
adopted by the committee on August 13, 2026

Fiscal Impact: Costs to local law enforcement agencies would be potentially reimbursable by the state, subject to a determination by the Commission on State Mandates.

Author Amendments: Delete requirements on law enforcement agencies to report data regarding transports to emergency departments and clarify requirements on peace officers regarding transports of persons under the LPS Act.
