AB 2780 (Committee on Public Employment and Retirement) – As Amended April 20, 2026

SUMMARY:

This bill makes several technical changes to existing teacher retirement and county employee retirement law administered by the California State Teachers' Retirement System (CalSTRS) and the 20 independent county employee retirement associations.

FISCAL EFFECT:

No new state costs.

COMMENTS:

In any given year, the public employee retirement system segments may propose minor and technical changes to the various laws within their respective jurisdictions to support efficient administration of those laws. This bill codifies those changes.

According to both CalSTRS and the State Association of County Retirement Systems, these changes promote integrity and efficiency in the administration of the effected retirement systems.
