Fiscal Impact:

 Costs of up to \$300,000 per year until the report due date of July 1, 2028 (Energy Resources Program Account) for the CEC to evaluate the cost-effectiveness of passive house building energy efficiency standards by climate zone and submit a report to the Legislature on its findings.

Committee Amendments: These amendments would delay the report due date from December 31, 2026 to July 1, 2028 and delay the sunset from 2029 to 2032.
