Fiscal Impact:

- Unknown costs, likely minor, for the Department of Managed Health Care (DMHC) and the California Department of Insurance (CDI) for state administration.
- Unknown potential General Fund costs to the extent there are increases in premiums for CalPERS plans.

Author Amendments: Clarify enrollee/insured benefits and authorize the DMHC and the CDI to issue guidance to plans/insurers, as specified.
