The following information is revised to reflect amendments adopted by the committee on August 29, 2025

**Fiscal Impact:** Unknown ongoing costs for the California Department of Public Health (CDPH), likely hundreds of thousands, to review medical chaperone policies and investigate complaints (Licensing and Certification Program Fund).

**Author Amendments:** Revise the definition of "provider;" specify that in the event a medical chaperone is unavailable at the time of the sensitive examination, the provider must coordinate with the patient to find an acceptable alternative, as specified; and make technical changes.
