**SUBJECT:** Mosquito Awareness Week

**DIGEST:** This resolution declares that the week of April 19, 2026, to April 25, 2026, inclusive, be designated as Mosquito Awareness Week.

**ANALYSIS:** This resolution makes the following legislative findings:

- 1) The United States Environmental Protection Agency recognizes that mosquito-borne diseases are currently among the world's leading causes of illness and death. The World Health Organization estimates that more than 300,000,000 clinical cases each year are attributable to mosquito-borne illnesses.
- 2) In 2025, 6 locally acquired human cases of dengue fever were detected in southern California, making it the third year of documented local transmission.
- 3) Mosquito Awareness Week will increase the public's awareness of the threat of dengue fever, West Nile virus, and other diseases, and the activities of the various mosquito vector surveillance and control agencies working to minimize the health threat within California, and will highlight the educational programs currently available.

This resolution declares that the week of April 19, 2026, to April 25, 2026, inclusive, be designated as Mosquito Awareness Week.
