ACR 39 (Ramos)

As Amended April 3, 2025

Majority vote

SUMMARY

Designates the month of May 2025 as California's Missing and Murdered Indigenous People Awareness Month.

Senate Amendments

Added a reference to the Missing and Murdered Indigenous People (MMIP) Summit hosted by the Yurok tribe since 2023. The Summit brings together tribal leaders from across the state, MMIP survivors, and victim advocates, as well as state lawmakers, federal partners, law enforcement, and academic researchers to identify solutions to stop the crisis and to bring awareness, education, and action by giving a voice to California's missing and murdered indigenous people and their families.

COMMENTS**According to the Author**

The Missing and Murdered Indigenous People (MMIP) crisis has plagued California tribes for generations, and progress has traditionally been slow. However, in recent years the state has made efforts to address MMIP. In order to effectively bring change, we must continue highlighting the issue to ensure we are hearing our tribal communities and working to find solutions to this crisis.

The Yocha Dehe Wintun Nation writes in support: "The crisis of missing and murdered Indigenous people affects tribes across the nation, causing immense pain and trauma. Historically, many of these cases have gone unsolved or uninvestigated, further amplifying the sense of injustice and heartbreak experienced by Indigenous communities."
