DIGEST: This trailer bill regarding special elections contains the necessary changes to implement provisions adopted as part of the Budget Act of 2025.

Assembly Amendments of 9/8/25 delete the senate version of this bill and instead add the current language.

ANALYSIS: This bill makes various statutory changes to implement the provisions of the Budget Act of 2025. Specifically, this bill makes the following statutory changes:

1) Ensures that counties have sufficient funding to effectuate the November 4, 2025 special election by appropriating General Funds for actual and reasonably necessary costs.

- 2) Uses any excess funds received by counties to offset costs for the next statewide election conducted by that particular county, where applicable.
- 3) Prohibits county elections officials from certifying the results of a local election before the 28th calendar day following such election (applies to elections called by a district, city, or other political subdivision on or before August 8, 2025, and scheduled to be held on November 4, 2025, with the special election).
