DIGEST: This resolution recognizes January 13, 2026, as Korean American Day.**ANALYSIS:** This resolution makes the following legislative findings:

- 1) Korean American Day is celebrated on January 13 of each year to not only commemorate the arrival of the first Korean immigrants to the United States, but also to honor Korean Americans' immense contributions to every aspect of society, including the important advancements of Californians in the fields of finance, technology, law, medicine, education, sports, media, the arts, the military, government, and other areas.
