DIGEST: This resolution recognizes May 10, 2026, as the 119th annual Mother's Day and would urge all Californians to recognize, appreciate, and be grateful for the gifts and good works of mothers on that day.

ANALYSIS: This resolution makes the following legislative findings:

- 1) A mother is one who nurtures her family, her community, her country, and her world. One in four mothers are raising their children without a spouse or partner. In the United States, more than 24,000,000 women are working mothers.
- 2) Mothers play an important role in educating, caring for, and raising the next generation of artists, scientists, and community leaders. Mother's Day is an opportunity to become better children and show our gratitude for those women who put the needs of others before their own needs.
- 3) Mother's Day also recognizes those who are trying to become mothers, those who have lost their mothers, and the people in our lives who have taken on the motherhood role.
