**SUBJECT:** Father's Day

**DIGEST:** This resolution observes June 21, 2026, as Father's Day and recognizes the contributions of fathers and father figures.

**ANALYSIS:** This resolution makes the following legislative findings:

- 1) Studies by the University of California, Berkeley, show that the presence of a close father in adult children's lives can have a significant influence on their social networks by providing both tangible and intangible skills and resources.
- 2) Children with supportive and engaged fathers tend to develop stronger social competence, healthier peer relationships, and improved communication and language skills. Supportive coparenting relationships between fathers and mothers are critically important and are associated with better self-regulation and fewer behavioral problems in children.
- 3) Positive father-child relationships are associated with higher life satisfaction and greater self-esteem among both boys and girls. In the words of President Barack Obama, fathers "are teachers and coaches. They are mentors and role models. They are examples of success and the men who constantly push us toward it".
