SUBJECT: International Day Against Homophobia, Biphobia, Interphobia, and Transphobia

DIGEST: This resolution recognizes May 17, 2026, as International Day Against Homophobia, Biphobia, Interphobia, and Transphobia (IDAHOBIT), and encourages all Californians to stand against hate, support LGBTQ+ communities, and promote a culture of inclusion, respect, and equality.

ANALYSIS: This resolution makes the following legislative findings:

- 1) International Day Against Homophobia, Biphobia, Interphobia, and Transphobia (IDAHOBIT) was established to draw global attention to the violence and discrimination experienced by LGBTQ+ people and to promote action to end these injustices.
- 2) Research demonstrates that LGBTQ+ youth face disproportionately high rates of bullying, family rejection, and homelessness, and are significantly more likely to experience mental health challenges, including depression and suicidal ideation, compared to their non-LGBTQ+ peers.
- 3) Observing IDAHOBIT provides an opportunity to reaffirm California's commitment to combating prejudice, promoting education, and advancing policies that ensure equity and justice for all.
