



HOUSE BILL 1095

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4;
Title 8; Title 38 and Title 49, relative to special
deputies.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 38-8-107, is amended by adding the
following as a new subsection:

() The commission shall also issue a certificate of compliance to a person
appointed as a special deputy; provided, that the person meets the qualifications for
employment as a police officer and satisfactorily completes an approved recruit training
program as required by this part. To retain this certification, the special deputy shall also
successfully complete an annual in-service training session appropriate for the special
deputy's responsibilities.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.

AMEND Senate Bill No. 790*

House Bill No. 1095

by deleting all language after the enacting clause and substituting:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 38-8-107, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:

(g) The commission shall also issue a certificate of compliance to a person appointed as a private special deputy on or after January 1, 2026, if the person meets the qualifications for employment as a police officer and satisfactorily completes an approved recruit training program as required by this part. To retain this certification, the private special deputy shall also successfully complete an annual in-service training session appropriate for the private special deputy's responsibilities. As used in this subsection (g), "private special deputy" means the same as defined in § 38-8-101.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
