



HOUSE BILL 1638

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 3;  
Title 4 and Title 9, relative to the state capitol  
complex.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-1-412, is amended by adding the  
following as a new subsection:

(j) The commission shall file a quarterly report with the governor, speaker of the senate, and speaker of the house of representatives detailing the status of each waiver filed with the commission affecting the state capitol complex. The commission shall file the report within fifteen (15) business days following the end of each calendar quarter, beginning with the quarter ending June 30, 2022, and include information for the preceding three-month period.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.

**AMEND Senate Bill No. 2349**

**House Bill No. 1638\***

by deleting all language after the enacting clause and substituting instead the following:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-8-101(a)(2), is amended by deleting the language "department of general services, through the commissioner acting with approval of the speaker of the senate and the speaker of the house of representatives, to" and substituting instead the language "speaker of the senate and the speaker of the house of representatives to".

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-3-102, is amended by adding the following new language to the end of the section:

For purposes of this section, the second floor of the state capitol is considered a state building occupied predominantly by the legislative branch and is controlled as described by § 4-8-101(a)(2).

SECTION 3. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
