



HOUSE BILL 1986

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 40
and Title 41, relative to inmates.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 41-21-227(e), is amended by deleting the subsection and substituting instead:

(e) Whenever a furlough is granted to an inmate under the authority of this section, the department shall notify the chief law enforcement officer of the county and the police chief of the city, if any, in which the inmate resides that the inmate has been granted a furlough.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.

AMEND Senate Bill No. 1804*

House Bill No. 1986

by deleting all language after the enacting clause and substituting:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-25-129(a)(3), is amended by adding the following as a new subdivision:

(C) A county incurring expenses pursuant to a criminal prosecution under this subdivision (a)(3) shall provide an invoice of the expenses imposed on the county to the department of correction. Within sixty (60) days of receiving an invoice pursuant to this subdivision (a)(3)(C), the department shall pay the amount of the invoiced expenses permitted by law to the county.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
