AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4;  
Title 5; Title 6; Title 7; Title 54 and Title 65, relative  
to utilities.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 65-1-111, is amended by adding the  
following language after the first sentence:

The commission shall make the report available on its website in a publicly  
accessible location.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 65-26-101, is amended by deleting "with the least possible delay" and substituting "with the least possible delay, and a city, county, or metropolitan government shall not require the repair of pavement or sidewalk in excess of two hundred percent (200%) of the surface area disturbed during the inspection, installation, or connection to such pipes or natural gas mains or conductors".

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
