



HOUSE BILL 2314

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 7,
Chapter 51 and Title 39, relative to adult-oriented
entertainment.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 7-51-1107(b), is amended by deleting "ten (10) days" and substituting "ten (10) business days".

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.

AMEND Senate Bill No. 2481*

House Bill No. 2314

by deleting all language after the enacting clause and substituting:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 7-51-1104, is amended by adding the following as new subsections:

(g) The board shall not issue a license unless the applicant certifies that a sign no smaller than eight and one-half inches by eleven inches (8 1/2" x 11") is posted at each entrance of the establishment that states: "Attention: By engaging in this type of entertainment, you may be contributing to an increase in domestic assault, rape or sexual assault, and human trafficking."

(h) If an adult-oriented establishment lawfully offers for sale, loan, or use sexually oriented materials, including print, video, and other media, then the board shall not issue a license to the establishment unless the applicant certifies that signs are posted at each display of sexually oriented material that states: "For Your Information: Production of these materials may contribute to an increase in domestic assault, rape or sexual assault, and human trafficking."

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.

by deleting all language after the enacting clause and substituting:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 7-51-1104, is amended by adding the following as new subsections:

(g)

(1) The board shall not issue a license unless the applicant certifies that a sign is posted at each entrance of the establishment that states: "Attention: By engaging in this type of entertainment, you may be contributing to an increase in domestic assault, rape or sexual assault, and human trafficking."

(2) A sign posted pursuant to subdivision (g)(1) must be no smaller than eight and one-half inches by eleven inches (8 1/2" x 11"). The required language must be printed in at least forty-eight-point type in boldface, block letters, centered on the sign. The letters must be black on a white background.

(h)

(1) If an adult-oriented establishment lawfully offers for sale, loan, or use sexually oriented materials, including print, video, and other media, then the board shall not issue a license to the establishment unless the applicant certifies that a sign is posted at each display of sexually oriented material that states: "Attention: By purchasing, borrowing, or using this pornographic material, you may be contributing to an increase in domestic assault, rape or sexual assault, and human trafficking."

(2) A sign posted pursuant to subdivision (h)(1) must be no smaller than eight and one-half inches by eleven inches (8 1/2" x 11"). The required language must be printed in at least forty-eight-point type in boldface, block letters, centered on the sign. The letters must be black on a white background.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
