



HOUSE BILL 338

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 3;
Title 4; Title 8; Title 9; Title 10; Title 12; Title 13;
Title 14; Title 15; Title 41; Title 50 and Title 57,
relative to state government.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-4-114(a)(1), is amended by adding the following at the end of the subdivision:

Reports filed pursuant to this subdivision (a)(1) may be submitted electronically.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.

AMEND Senate Bill No. 354

House Bill No. 338*

by deleting all language after the enacting clause and substituting:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 12-2-116, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:

(d)

(1) Notwithstanding subsection (a) and this part, the commissioner of environment and conservation, with the approval of the state building commission, may enter into the agreements contemplated in this section for the private development, redevelopment, construction, and operation of facilities on lands under its jurisdiction, and the department of environment and conservation may supervise the construction. Such agreements may include provisions for the sale, lease, or other conveyance of state-owned real property, subject to the approval of the commissioner of environment and conservation and the state building commission. The requirements of § 12-2-112 do not apply to such conveyances.

(2) Subdivision (d)(1) applies only to Cumberland Mountain State Park.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 12-2-116(a)(1), is amended by deleting the language "Notwithstanding any other provisions of this part" and substituting "Notwithstanding this part, except as provided in subsection (d)".

SECTION 3. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
