



HOUSE BILL 413

**AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 38
and Title 40, relative to probation and parole
officers.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-28-604, is amended by deleting the section and substituting instead the following:

No person shall be eligible for the position of probation and parole officer who has not received a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university or had at least four (4) years of qualifying full-time professional experience. As used in this section, "qualifying full-time professional experience" includes law enforcement experience or service in any branch of the United States armed forces.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-28-604, is amended by deleting the section and substituting instead the following:
