



HOUSE BILL 91

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 10
and Section 37-5-107, relative to the confidentiality
of records.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 37-5-107(b), is amended by adding
the following as a new subdivision:

(3) The department may disclose information about a case to the public if all
parties involved in the case, including the child, are deceased and all identifying
personal information of the parties is redacted. As used in this subdivision (b)(3),
"identifying personal information" includes, but is not limited to, name, date of birth,
address, and social security number.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.

by deleting all language after the enacting clause and substituting:

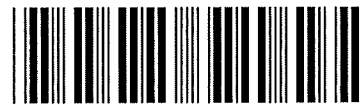
SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 37-5-107(b), is amended by adding the following as a new subdivision:
