SENATE BILL 1131

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-8-185, relative to operation of off-highway vehicles on certain highways.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-8-185(c)(1)(D), is amended by deleting the language "on any two (2) weekends per year".

SECTION 2. This act does not require a local legislative body that has approved the

operation of off-highway vehicles pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-8-

185(c)(1)(D), as that provision existed prior to the effective date of this act, to resubmit and

reapprove such operation on or after the effective date of this act.

SECTION 3. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.

by deleting all language after the enacting clause and substituting:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-8-185(c)(1)(C), is amended by deleting the language "on any two (2) weekends per year".

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-8-185(c)(1)(D), is amended by deleting the language "on any two (2) weekends per year".

SECTION 3. This act does not require a local legislative body that has approved the operation of off-highway vehicles pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-8-185(c)(1)(C) or (c)(1)(D), as those provisions existed prior to the effective date of this act, to resubmit and reapprove such operation on or after the effective date of this act.

SECTION 4. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
