



SENATE BILL 1590

**AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 11,
Chapter 13, relative to scenic rivers.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 11-13-104, is amended by:

(1) Deleting "Buffalo River — The entire river, except that portion which lies within Wayne, Perry, Humphreys and Lewis counties" and substituting "Buffalo River — The entire river";

(2) Deleting "Duck River — That segment of the Duck River beginning at Iron Bridge Road at river mile 136.4 extending continuously to a point upstream to the boundary of Marshall County at river mile 173.7.";

(3) Deleting "Duck River — That segment of the Duck River beginning at Industrial Park Road approximately at river mile 128 extending continuously to a point downstream to the boundary of Hickman County at approximately river mile 98 downstream from the Natchez Trace River Bridge" and substituting "Duck River — The entire river except that segment of the river designated by the Tennessee Valley Authority as part of Normandy Reservoir"; and

(4) Adding the following under the designation "Class II Pastoral River Areas":

Beaverdam Creek – That segment beginning with the confluence of Brush Fork and Piney Fork in Hickman County and ending with its confluence with the Duck River in Hickman County.

Lick Creek – That segment beginning with the confluence of North Fork Lick Creek and South Fork Lick Creek in Williamson County and ending with its confluence with the Duck River in Hickman County.

Piney River – That segment beginning with the confluence of the West Piney River and the East Piney River in Dickson County and ending with its confluence with the Duck River in Hickman County.

Swan Creek – That segment beginning with the confluence of Dry Branch and Swan Creek in Hickman County and ending with its confluence with the Duck River in Hickman County.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 11-13-108(b)(1), is amended by deleting the phrase "of Duck River" and replacing it with "of any river".

SECTION 3. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.

House Bill No. 1510

by adding the following section immediately preceding the effective date section and renumbering the subsequent section accordingly:

SECTION __. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 11-13-111(b), is amended by adding the following as a new subdivision (3):

(3) Subdivision (b)(1) does not prohibit construction, operation, or expansion of a landfill that has a valid landfill permit on the effective date of this act, and that is located within two (2) miles of the center of:

(A) The portion of the Buffalo River that lies within Wayne, Perry, Humphreys, and Lewis counties;

(B) The segment of Beaverdam Creek beginning with the confluence of Brush Fork and Piney Fork in Hickman County and ending with its confluence with the Duck River in Hickman County;

(C) The segment of Lick Creek beginning with the confluence of North Fork Lick Creek and South Fork Lick Creek in Williamson County and ending with its confluence with the Duck River in Hickman County;

(D) The segment of the Piney River beginning with the confluence of the West Piney River and the East Piney River in Dickson County and ending with its confluence with the Duck River in Hickman County;

(E) The segment of Swan Creek beginning with the confluence of Dry Branch and Swan Creek in Hickman County and ending with its confluence with the Duck River in Hickman County; and

(F) The segments of the Duck River other than:

(i) The segment of the Duck River beginning at Iron Bridge Road at river mile 136.4 extending continuously to a point upstream to the boundary of Marshall County at river mile 173.7; and

(ii) The segment of the Duck River beginning at Industrial Park Road approximately at river mile 128 extending continuously to a point downstream to the boundary of Hickman County at approximately river mile 98 downstream from the Natchez Trace River Bridge.
