



SENATE BILL 1684

**AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55,
Chapter 21, relative to pregnancy.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-21-102(3), is amended by adding the following as a new subdivision (D):

"Disabled driver" also includes a person who is in the second or third trimester of a pregnancy or who has a pregnancy certified to be high risk by the person's physician;

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.

AMEND Senate Bill No. 1684

House Bill No. 1457*

by deleting all language after the enacting clause and substituting instead the following:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-21-103(b)(2), is amended by deleting subdivision (C) and substituting instead the following:

(C) Temporary placards may be issued under this part to persons who are temporarily disabled by a nonambulatory or semi-ambulatory condition due to surgery, bone fracture or breakage, or similar condition, and whose temporary disabling condition and the estimated duration of the condition is noted on the physician's statement. Temporary placards may also be issued to a female who has a pregnancy certified to be high risk by her physician. Temporary placards must be issued for the estimated duration of the condition, but not in excess of six (6) months, at a cost of ten dollars (\$10.00). Temporary placards may be reissued for a similar period at the same cost. Temporary placards must be of a different design and color than permanent placards and must prominently note the expiration date.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect January 1, 2027, the public welfare requiring it.
