



**SENATE BILL 1713**

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4; Title 5; Title 6; Title 7 and Title 49, relative to discriminatory preferences.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-1-427, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:

(c) The executive head of each department, agency, or other unit of state government subject to this section shall submit an annual attestation of compliance with subsection (a) to the comptroller of the treasury not later than January 1, 2027, and each January 1 thereafter.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 5-1-135, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:

(c) The executive head of each county government subject to this section shall submit an annual attestation of compliance with subsection (a) to the comptroller of the treasury not later than January 1, 2027, and each January 1 thereafter.

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 6-54-150, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:

(c) The executive head of each municipal government subject to this section shall submit an annual attestation of compliance with subsection (a) to the comptroller of the treasury not later than January 1, 2027, and each January 1 thereafter.

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 7-3-107, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:

(c) The executive head of each metropolitan government subject to this section shall submit an annual attestation of compliance with subsection (a) to the comptroller of the treasury not later than January 1, 2027, and each January 1 thereafter.

SECTION 5. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-7-192, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:

(c) The executive head or president of each public institution of higher education subject to this section shall submit an annual attestation of compliance with subsection (a) to the comptroller of the treasury not later than January 1, 2027, and each January 1 thereafter.

SECTION 6. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.

**AMEND Senate Bill No. 1713**

**House Bill No. 1664\***

by deleting all language after the enacting clause and substituting:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-1-427, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:

(c) The executive head of each department, agency, or other unit of state government subject to this section shall submit an annual attestation of compliance with subsection (a) to the comptroller of the treasury not later than January 1, 2027, and each January 1 thereafter.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 5-1-135, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:

(c) The executive head of each county government subject to this section shall submit an annual attestation of compliance with subsection (a) to the comptroller of the treasury not later than January 1, 2027, and each January 1 thereafter.

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 6-54-150, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:

(c) The executive head of each municipal government subject to this section shall submit an annual attestation of compliance with subsection (a) to the comptroller of the treasury not later than January 1, 2027, and each January 1 thereafter.

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 7-3-107, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:

(c) The executive head of each metropolitan government subject to this section shall submit an annual attestation of compliance with subsection (a) to the comptroller of the treasury not later than January 1, 2027, and each January 1 thereafter.

SECTION 5. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-7-192, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:

(c) The executive head or president of each public institution of higher education or the chief executive head of any of its campuses subject to this section shall submit an annual attestation of compliance with subsection (a) to the comptroller of the treasury not later than January 1, 2027, and each January 1 thereafter.

SECTION 6. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
