



SENATE BILL 1720

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2 and Title 10, Chapter 7, relative to public records.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-5-102, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:

(c) Notwithstanding § 10-7-503, the addresses on a nominating petition for the office of judge, chancellor, district attorney general, and public defender are confidential and are not open to public inspection.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 10-7-504(f)(1), is amended by adding the following as a new subdivision:

() Except as provided in § 10-7-503(f), the application materials submitted by an individual when seeking employment with the governmental entity.

SECTION 3. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.

by deleting Section 1 and substituting:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-5-102, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:

(c) Notwithstanding § 10-7-503, the addresses on a nominating petition for the office of judge, chancellor, district attorney general, and public defender are confidential and are not open to public inspection, unless requested by a candidate or law enforcement authority in anticipation of or as part of a contest of candidacy or contest of election. A person requesting such information shall certify on a form provided by the coordinator of elections the reason for the request under penalty of perjury.
