

## SENATE BILL 351

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 5; Title 6; Title 7; Title 8; Title 12 and Title 13, relative to local government.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 5, Chapter 1, Part 1, is amended by adding the following as a new section:

In addition to any other duties prescribed to the county attorney by general law, private act, or county ordinance, the county attorney shall consult with and advise elected county officials, elected county officials' deputies, and elected county officials' employees as to the proper application and enforcement of federal and state laws that are pertinent to carrying out the duties of the county officials' respective offices.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 6, Chapter 54, Part 1, is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated section:

In addition to any other duties prescribed to the city attorney by general law, private act, or city ordinance, the city attorney shall consult with and advise elected city officials, elected city officials' deputies, and elected city officials' employees as to the proper application and enforcement of federal and state laws that are pertinent to carrying out the duties of the city officials' respective offices.

SECTION 3. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.

**AMEND Senate Bill No. 351**

**House Bill No. 337\***

by deleting all language after the enacting clause and substituting:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 7, Chapter 51, is amended by adding the following as a new part:

**7-51-2601.**

As used in this part:

(1) "Guaranteed income program":

(A) Means a program under which an individual is issued an unconditional cash payment on a regular basis to be used for any purpose by the individual; and

(B) Does not include a program under which an individual is required to seek reemployment, perform work, or attend work training as a condition of a cash payment; and

(2) "Local government" means a county, incorporated city or town, metropolitan government, or an agency or unit thereof, or other political subdivision of this state.

**7-51-2602.**

Notwithstanding another law to the contrary, a local government shall not adopt or enforce an ordinance, resolution, regulation, code, requirement, or policy that has the purpose or effect of making a payment to an individual under a guaranteed income program.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
